



EPP Regulation Notification and Information Requirements

As part of our continual safety and compliance efforts, we want to highlight to you some important changes impacting our industry.

The government has recently revised the Poisons Act 1972 and expanded the requirements and products in scope of this legislation.

As a result, from 1st October 2023 all sellers of the substances listed below are now obligated to collect, record and retain critical information from their customers for sales of Regulated explosive precursors.

In order to comply and to help avoid any delays to the order process and delivery, we ask that if you currently buy, or intend to buy, any of these products from 6 Science you;

Complete the attached form – which includes the minimum expectations of the legislation - and return it, along with a copy of photographic identification to info@6science.co.uk

Our understanding is that this is only required once every 18 months and will cover multiple product purchases. For example, if you buy both Nitric Acid and Phosphoric acid from 6 Science you are only required to complete the form once.

All information collected will be managed within GDPR guidelines.

Regulated substances and concentration thresholds.

Explosives precursors

ammonium nitrate: 16% and above

hexamine

hydrochloric acid: 10% w/w and above

hydrogen peroxide: 12% w/w and above

nitromethane: 30% w/w and above

nitric acid: 3% w/w and above

phosphoric acid: 30% w/w and above

potassium chlorate: 40% w/w and above

potassium perchlorate: 40% w/w and above

sodium chlorate: 40% w/w and above

sodium perchlorate: 40% w/w and above

sulphuric acid: 15% w/w and above
